Report to BDTPA from your 30 Mile Rep. August 7, 2020

The Covid-19 pandemic has led to some changes in the activities of 30 Mile. Work which directly impacts our association continues as follows:

Water quality monitoring: Secchi disc test and measurement of temperature and dissolved oxygen are recorded every two weeks and the compiled information is available on the [30 Mile website](#).

Lake Smart program: Preliminary evaluations of properties are available to homeowners this summer and there is also a special program called Lake Smart Start which assists folks who wish to do their own preliminary evaluations. It is expected that Lake Smart will be up and running fully in 2021.

The volunteer Invasive Plant Patrol continues. Volunteers always needed!

Various other 30 Mile programs have had to be adapted due to the pandemic. Courtesy Boat inspectors are working at four of the launches in the watershed with Covid-19 protocols in effect.

Both the Paddle Trek and the From the Top benefit concert had to be cancelled. We hope to have these events back on the schedule in 2021.

In addition, the Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) is not happening this summer, however applications are being taken for projects for the summer of 2021.
