Spring has finally arrived. The loons have returned to our ponds! Please remind your family and guests not to get too close to them or to climb on the small island during nesting season. Also please respect the no-wake zones as boat wakes disturb nesting shoreline birds.

The water level on the ponds is high, normal for this time of year. We plan to continue monitoring the levels and the condition of our dam.

Please see the attached letter from our local health officer with important information for people who are coming from out of state or who may be returning from travel. **Rules in Maine may differ from where you are.** Please read carefully and comply with the guidelines for the safety of all.

We are uncertain as to the status of our August meeting. We will conform to distancing guidelines in place as the time draws nearer.
